## WHAT?

Outdoor labor in remote and rugged terrain. Crews will work in all weather conditions.

## PAY?

Laborers— \$15/hr

Crew Leads—\$20/hr

## Qualified?

- ✓ **18 years of age or older**
- ✓ **Unemployed since October 1st 2015**  
(or minimum of 15-1/2 consecutive weeks out of the last 26 week)
- ✓ **3 forms of identification necessary**  
(must be recognized by the State of CA or the Federal Government)
- ✓ **Selective Service registered\***
- ✓ **Preference for local commuting area**
- ✓ **No housing available**

\*male applicants born after December 31st 1959 must certify they have registered with the Selective Service System or are exempt

\*\*\* If you lost your job due to the fires please be sure to let Intake Specialist know when filing your application
